WHITING PARK RECREATIONAL AREA RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Prohibited items include glass containers, balloons, and confetti. Patrons will be asked to remove any prohibited items or be asked to leave Whiting Park.
- All patrons must check in at the service counter upon arrival.
- Pets are allowed inside WPRA, but must remain on a leash at all times. The only exception to this rule is when they are in the dog wading area on the North side of the park. Pets are prohibited inside the beach wading area as well as any motorized craft rented from WPRA.
- Overnight parking is not permitted without prior approval from management.
- Patrons who appear intoxicated, become violent, or use abusive language will be removed from WPRA by NAS Whiting Field Security.
- Pavilion Rule:
 - o Reservations for pavilions must be made in person, up to 3 months in advance
 - Authorized patrons who sponsor a reservation at the pavilion must arrive first before any guests, as well as check in/pay at the service counter.
 - o Sponsors must remain onsite during entire use of pavilion
 - Guest lists for private functions must be turned into WPRA no later than 5 business days from date of rental
 - o Pavilions should be empty 30 minutes prior to closing.

• Motorized Vessel Rules:

- o Patrons who have received our MWR Boater Safety Card may make motorizedvessel rentals over the phone; all other reservations must be made in person.
- o Reservations may be made up to 1 month in advance.
- Patrons born after January 1, 1988 must possess their State Boater License before obtaining a MWR Boater Safety Card.
- In the event of inclement or hazardous weather, patrons will be called to return to Whiting Park and provided a rain check for any remaining rental time to be used on a future date.
- o At time of rental, patrons will review safety material with MWR team member as well as sign Check out forms/Liability Waivers.
- o All rented vessels must be returned to WPRA at least one hour prior to closing.
- Kayak and Canoe Drop-off Rule:
 - o Drop-off activity must be reserved at least 1 week in advance
 - o A 3 vessel minimum is required
 - o Patrons must return to WPRA at least one hour prior to closing.
